Subject:- Proposal for Financial Assistance under HRD Scheme for creation of Infrastructure facilities for B.Sc ( Food Science & Technology) Course.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the aforesaid proposal and convey the "in-principle" approval for grant-in-aid of Rs. 75,00,000/= (Rupees Seventy Five Lakhs Only) for creation of infrastructure facilities for B.Sc ( Food Science & Technology) course under HRD scheme. The release of grant will be subject to fulfillment of following standards conditions / guidelines and availability of funds and also the following conditions:

- (A). The grant will be released in two equal installments for the purchase of Machineries/ equipments as per the approved list as enclosed.
- (B). The first installment will be released on receipt of confirmations to compliance of following conditions:
  - (i) Surety bond on Rs. 100/- stamp paper duly notarized in the enclosed format for Rs. 75,00,000/=.
  - (ii) Confirmation that recurring expenditure will be borne by the Institute/ University and balance equipments or cost difference in approved equipments, if any, in the project shall be borne from the Institute/ University's own funds.
  - (iii) Confirmation on availability of funds to meet the Institutes/ University's contribution as indicated in the means of finance.
  - (iv) An undertaking on a non judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/-, duly notarized, confirming that the university will run the course for a minimum period of ten years.
  - (v) Information for fund transfer in enclosed Mandate form.
  - (vi) Confirmation that the university shall appoint at least two faculties with qualification of food technology for the proposed course before release of the second installment.
  - (vii) The equipments shall be purchased by following due tender procedure.
  - (viii) The university will prominently display on stone on the building that the project is assisted by Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
  - (ix) Submission of half yearly progress report in the enclosed format.
