- 5. Number of MoUs signed with premier institutions/Industries/Research Laboratories/NGOs to facilitate students' projects/internships.
- 6. Laboratory facilities have been improved. A number of sophisticated analytical instruments have been procured for Central Instrumentation Facilities to accelerate the research activities.
