The Director IQAC presented the report of the action taken based on stakeholders' feedback before the Council. The major action taken are as follows:

1. The curriculum has been modified keeping in view the syllabi of NET and other Competitive Examinations and to suit the requirement of industry and job market. The syllabus of the following UG and PG programmes have been revised which has been made effective from the academic session 2018-19.

2. Library books and other learning resources including online subscription have been enhanced.
3. University LMS has been enriched so as to share reading materials/ppt presentations and e-content lessons prepared by teachers.
4. Conduct of workshop, Training Programmes, Career Counselling Sessions, Orientation Programmes, Finishing School facilities, ICT Facilities etc were revamped for enhanced learning and holistic development of students. Coaching facilities for Competitive Examinations have always remained a key focus of the authority.
5. Number of MoUs signed with premier institutions/Industries/Research Laboratories/NGOs to facilitate students' projects/internships.
6. Laboratory facilities have been improved. A number of sophisticated analytical instruments have been procured for Central Instrumentation Facilities to accelerate the research activities.
