This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this date of 1st March of the year 2018 between Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati, North Guwahati, Assam – 781039, India – as the First Part;

And

University of Science and Technology, Meghalaya, 9th Mile, Baridua, Ri-Bhoi - 793101 – as the Second part; herein together referred to as “the Universities”.

Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati (IITG) is an autonomous body incorporated under the Institute of Technology Act 1961, as amended up-to-date and established in 1994 having its office at Guwahati, hereby represented by its Director. IIT Guwahati is the only academic institute in India that occupied a place among the top 100 world universities – under 50 years of age – in world ranking. It is one of the most dynamic institutions in India, with one of the most beautiful educational campuses in the country that provides an ideal setting for learning and research. The institute is fully residential for the students, enriched with world-class facilities and is empowered with a young dynamic faculty and staff.

And

University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya, having its registered office at Techno City, 9th Mile, Baridua, Meghalaya, hereinafter called “USTM”, is established by an act of Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya State in 2008. The objective of USTM is to impart world class education exploring opportunities and talents of North East region, thereby, creating cutting edge research centre and build a Knowledge Capital for societal development. USTM is an upcoming University with minimal resources and high ambition trying for academic excellence.

Whereas USTM has requested IITG to **mentor** the upcoming University to achieve its objectives, through various programmes for the academic promotion and administrative guidance with the following identified but not limited to,

1. **IITG Faculty support to USTM** – Identified Faculty of IITG shall take classes at USTM for the identified courses and syllabus with mutual consultation by USTM faculty with IITG Faculty. The IITG faculty, who have agreed and take classes at USTM, shall be provided with Transport, Accommodation facilities and an honorarium per lecture as per USTM norms. IIT Guwahati faculty members willing to do so will seek prior approval of the Director, IIT Guwahati to undertake such a task.
2. **IITG to host selected USTM Students for short period** – IITG will host students identified by USTM in different disciplines at IITG for 10-15 days for attending special

- classes or regular classes with IITG students in class rooms and laboratories as per the plan of IITG to impart greater exposures in the respective subjects. During the period, IITG will provide hostel accommodation to USTM students. Prior approval and agreement of the Head of the concerned department is to be obtained to allow students to work in laboratories at IIT Guwahati for projects, internships, etc. On recommendation of the concerned Department at IITG, Director IITG will be the sole authority to grant final approval.
3. **Final Year Projects of USTM Students** – IITG will permit some selected final year students of USTM on mutual consultation, to do their Project Work at IITG. Prior approval of the Director, IIT Guwahati is to be obtained.
 4. **Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects** – IITG faculty will involve some of the selected faculty of USTM to be Co-investigator in their project proposals for funding and vice versa. IIT Guwahati faculty members willing to do so will seek prior approval of the Director, IIT Guwahati to undertake such a task.
 5. **Seminars / symposia / workshop to be jointly organized** – Some of the selected seminars / workshops / symposiums organized by the various departments of IITG and USTM either by faculty or students to be held jointly on mutual consultation by the respective faculty on case to case basis.
 6. **Organize the visitors of IITG to visit USTM** – IITG will try to request and facilitate the visitors / guests coming to IITG to visit USTM also on their way.
 7. **Guidance in University Administration** – USTM is an upcoming University and a beginner in many aspects. IITG will provide guidance to USTM staff in Administration in areas like examination, admissions, recruitment of staff and organizing Convocation.
 8. **Guidance in infrastructure development** – IITG will guide USTM in upgrading of University infrastructure like laboratories, equipments, library, class rooms, recreational facilities, hostels, campus maintenance by providing necessary specifications and operational guidance where required.
 9. **Sports promotion** – IITG and USTM will conduct some inter University friendly matches in selected sports on mutual consultation.
 10. There shall be no financial obligation on IIT Guwahati as a partner in this MoU.

Both IITG and USTM agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this Memorandum of Understanding, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.



Incidental expenses, if any with respect to the activities mentioned above will be met by USTM. Any expenditure w.r.t. visit of the IITG staff to USTM will be met by USTM.

Subject to clauses below, both the institutions may amend this Memorandum of Understanding by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Universities shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing institutions on potential areas.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the institutions shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this Memorandum of Understanding. However, IITG has freedom to continue or discontinue the MoU at its own discretion.

The institutions agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall not be legally bound. Nothing mentioned in this Memorandum of Understanding shall deem constitute partnership between the signing institutions appointing one party as an agent of the other. This Memorandum of Understanding will be effective upon signature by both the Chief Executive Officers for a period of three years, at which time will be reviewed for possible renewal for further three-year period. Either party may, on three (03) months notice in writing, terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration or request the recognition of its conditions.



Those faculties of USTM who are interested to be recognised as supervisor / Co-supervisor of JNU, shall apply for such recognition to the Controller of Examinations, JNU. The competent authority of JNU will consider such request on priority as per provisions of JNU rules..



2. **JNU to host selected USTM Students for short period and vice versa** – JNU and USTM will host students Identified by respective Universities in different disciplines at **JNU/USTM under the student exchange** for attending special classes or regular classes with JNU/USTM students in class rooms and laboratories as per the plan of JNU/USTM to impart greater exposure in the respective subjects. During the period, JNU/USTM will try to provide decent hostel accommodation to all students, subject to availability of accommodation in JNU and prior intimation.
3. **North East Studies:** Both the Universities have agreed to work jointly on different issues of North Eastern region- covering its language, its varied cultural diversity, its food habits and its vast biodiversity.
4. **Final Year Projects of USTM Students** – JNU will permit some selected final year students of USTM on mutual consultation, to do their Project Work at JNU.
5. **Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects** – JNU faculty will involve some of the selected faculty of USTM to be Co-investigator in their project proposals for funding and vice versa.
6. **Seminars/ symposia/workshop to be jointly organized** – Some of the selected seminars / workshops / symposiums organized by the various departments of JNU and USTM either by faculty or students to be held jointly on mutual consultation by the respective faculty on case to case basis.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the **Universities** shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this Memorandum of Understanding. *However, JNU has freedom to continue or discontinue the MOU at its own discretion*

Jurisdiction Clause

In case of any dispute arising out of this MOU between the parties, there will be the Grievances Redresses mechanism and civil court at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try the matter/dispute.

First party: JAMIA MILLIA ISLAMIA, Jamia Nagar, New Delhi – 110025 hereinafter referred to as **JMI** is a Centre University under an enactment of the Parliament of India (i.e. the Jamia Millia Islamia Act, 1988) and is a body corporate with a perpetual succession. The objective of the University is to strive to provide employment oriented higher education and promote research.

Second party: University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya, having its registered office at Techno City, 9th Mile, Baridua, Meghalaya, hereinafter called "**USTM**", is established by an act of Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya State in 2008 promoted by Education Research and Development Foundation, Guwahati. The objective of USTM is to impart world class education exploring opportunities and talents of north east region, thereby, creating cutting edge research centre and build a Knowledge Capital for societal development. USTM is an upcoming university with minimal resources and high ambition trying for academic excellence.

Whereas USTM has requested JMI to mentor the upcoming university to achieve its objectives, through various programmes for the academic promotion and administrative guidance with the following identified but not limited to,

Article 1 - To develop the following collaborative activities in academic area of mutual interest

1. **Award of Ph.D Degrees** – The students who would like to register for Ph.D at USTM will be given option to opt for joint supervision – one from USTM and one from JMI subject to availability of vacancy as per UGC guidelines. Those faculties of USTM who are interested to be recognized

as Supervisor / Co-supervisor of JMI, shall apply for such recognition to the Controller of Examinations, Jamia Millia Islamia. The competent authority of Jamia Millia Islamia will consider such request on priority as per provisions of JMI rules.

2. **JMI Faculty support to USTM** – Identify Faculty of JMI in the areas of Biotechnology, Chemistry, Environment Science, Business Administration, Social Sciences and Engineering shall take classes at USTM for the identified courses and syllabus with mutual consultation by USTM faculty with JMI Faculty. The JMI faculty, who would be assigned duties at USTM, shall be provided with Transport, Accommodation facilities and an honorarium per lecture as per USTM norms.
3. **JMI to host selected USTM Students for short period** – JMI will host students Identified by USTM in different disciplines at JMI for 10-15 days for attending special classes or regular classes with JMI students in class rooms and laboratories as per the plan of JMI to impart greater exposure in the respective subjects. During the period, JMI will provide hostel accommodation to USTM. The cost of stay in the hostel will be borne either by the students themselves or by USTM.
4. **Final Year Projects of USTM Students** – JMI will permit some selected final year students of USTM on mutual consultation, to do their project work at JMI.
5. **Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects** – JMI faculty will involve some of the selected faculty of USTM to be Co-Investigator in their project proposals for funding and vice versa.
6. **Seminars / symposia / workshop to be jointly organized** – Some of the selected seminars / workshops / symposiums organized by the various departments of JMI and USTM either by faculty or students to be held jointly by mutual consultation by the respective faculty on case to case basis.

Article 5 – This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years.

Thereafter, the Universities shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this Memorandum of Understanding. However, JMI has freedom to continue or discontinue the MOU at its own discretion.

Article 6 – The Universities agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall have no legal binding. Nothing mentioned in this Memorandum of Understanding shall deem to constitute partnership between the signing Universities appointing one party as an agent of the other. This Memorandum of Understanding will be effective upon signature by both the Vice-Chancellors for a period of three years. This time will be reviewed for possible renewal for further three-year period. Either party may, on three months notice in writing terminate the MOU in advance of its normal expiration.

Article 7 – This Memorandum of Undertaking shall require the ratification of the competent Academic / Executive body of the First Party Jamia Millia Islamia and the concerned Academic / Executive body of the Second party University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya.





The objective of **USTM** is to impart world class education exploring opportunities and talents of north east region, thereby, creating cutting edge research centre and build a Knowledge Capital for societal development. **USTM** is an upcoming university with minimal resources and high ambition trying for academic excellence.

Whereas **USTM** has requested **GU** to mentor the upcoming university to achieve its objectives, through various programmes for the academic promotion and administrative guidance with the following identified fields but not limited to :

1. **Award of Ph. D Degrees** – The students who would like to register for Ph. D at **USTM** will be given option to opt for joint supervision – one from **USTM** and another from **GU**. Those faculties of **GU**, who are interested to be recognised as supervisor / Co-supervisor of **USTM**, shall apply for such recognition to the Controller of Examinations, **USTM**. Similarly, those faculties of **USTM** who are interested to be recognised as supervisor / Co-supervisor of **GU** shall apply for such recognition to the Controller of Examinations, Gauhati University. The competent authority of **the Universities** will consider such request on priority as per provisions of their rules.
2. **GU Faculty support to USTM** – Identified Faculty of **GU** in the areas of Applied Sciences, Biological Sciences, Environment Sciences, Business Sciences, Social Sciences, Engineering Sciences & Technology, Education and Law shall take classes at **USTM** for the identified courses and syllabus with mutual consultation by **USTM** faculty with **GU** Faculty. The **GU** faculty, who have agreed to take classes at **USTM**, shall be provided with Transport, Accommodation facilities and an honorarium per lecture as per **USTM** norms.
3. **GU to host selected USTM Students for short period** - **GU** will host students identified by **USTM** in different disciplines at **GU** for 10-15 days for attending special classes or regular classes with **GU** students in class rooms and laboratories as per the plan of **GU** to impart greater exposure in the respective subjects. During the period, **GU** will provide hostel accommodation to **USTM** students.
4. **Final Year Projects of USTM Students** – **GU** will permit some selected final year students of **USTM** on mutual consultation to do their Project Work at **GU**.
5. **Joint Submission of Collaborative Projects** – **GU** faculty will involve some of the selected faculty of **USTM** to be Co-investigator in their project proposals for funding and vice versa.
6. **Joint organization of Seminars/ symposia/workshop to be**– Some of the selected seminars / workshops / symposiums organized by the various departments of **GU** and **USTM** either by faculty or students to be held jointly on mutual consultation by the respective faculty on case to case basis.

7. **Facilitate the visitors of GU to visit USTM** - GU will try to request and facilitate the visitors / guests coming to GU to visit USTM also on their way.
8. **Guidance in University Administration** – USTM is an upcoming university and a beginner in many aspects. GU will provide guidance to USTM staff in Administration in areas like examination, admissions, recruitment of staff and organizing Convocation.
9. **Guidance in infrastructure development** - GU will guide USTM in upgrading of university infrastructure like laboratories, equipments, library, class rooms, recreational facilities, hostels, campus maintenance by providing necessary specifications and operational guidance wherever required.
10. **Sports promotion** – GU and USTM will conduct some inter university friendly matches in selected sports on mutual consultation.

Both GU and USTM agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding will be kept **strictly confidential** and used solely for the purpose, covered by this Memorandum of Understanding, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information-disclosing party and entered public domain.



1. **Faculty Exchange**– Identified Faculty of CIPET shall take classes at USTM and vice versa, to harness the strength of respective institution's human resources.

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and executed on the 27th day of the month of April, 2015 between University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya situated in Techno City, 9th Mile, Baridua, Ri-Bhoi, Meghalaya, hereinafter referred as USTM. The university is established under Act 6 of 2008 enacted by the State Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya and incorporated under section 22 & 2 (f) of the UGC Act 1956.

And

North Eastern Space Applications Centre (NESAC), a premier institute established by the Department of Space, Government of India and North Eastern Council to work in the area of applications of space science and technology in the North Eastern Region of India, hereinafter referred as NESAC. The office of NESAC is situated at Umiam, Ri Bhoi district, Meghalaya.

Preamble

University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya (USTM) have its registered office at Techno City, 9th Mile, Baridua, Ri-Bhoi, Meghalaya is established by an act of Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya State in 2008. The objective of USTM is to provide high class education of modern age exploring opportunities and talents of the North East Region, thereby, creating cutting edge research centre and build a **Knowledge Hub** for societal development. USTM is an upcoming university with enormous potentialities and high ambition trying for academic excellence. Considering education as the backbone of a healthy society, USTM intend to produce future leaders and policy makers of tomorrow for fulfillment of dreams of the country especially for the NE Region.

North Eastern Space Applications Centre (NESAC) is a joint initiative of Department of Space (DOS) and the North Eastern Council (NEC) to provide developmental support to the north eastern region (NER) of our country using space science and technology. The major objectives of the Centre are: i) to provide an operational remote sensing based natural resource information base to assist activities on development / management of natural resources and infrastructure planning in the region ii) to provide operational satellite communication applications services in the region in education, health care, disaster management support, and

developmental communication and iii) to establish a space science and climatic change research hub by installation of necessary instrumentation and networking with various academic institutions of NER.

Purpose & Objectives:

The purpose of this MoU is to create a framework for collaboration between USTM and NESAC with the objectives as given below:

1. To establish close linkage and functional coordination between USTM and NESAC.
2. To recognize NESAC as an accredited research centre for research and study directed by USTM and vice versa.
3. To consider the scientists, designated scholars and management professionals of NESAC as an accredited faculty/supervisor for different research, teaching and management programmes of USTM subjected to their meeting the basic criteria.
4. To facilitate joint seeking of funds, submission of project proposals for research and development, training, consultancy and project management with funding agencies.
5. USTM and NESAC shall meet the expenses for the respective purposes and activities under this MoU from their own resources.

The MoU will be governed by the following conditions:

1. USTM and NESAC shall support each other towards the advancement of knowledge and R&D activities of the employees, faculty, scholars and students of both the organizations.
2. USTM will provide all facilities to the employees (Scientific and Technical staff) and scholars (Research Fellows and Project Assistants) of NESAC to enroll for Ph.D. programme at the USTM under joint supervision as per university admission procedure.
3. NESAC shall facilitate the students, scholars and faculties of USTM to conduct studies and researches required for partial fulfillment of requirements leading to the award of PG and Ph.D. degree by USTM. Number of candidates to be taken up under each of the degrees at a time shall depend upon the availability of supervising scientists and laboratory space. **Director, NESAC** shall be the ultimate authority to decide in such cases.
4. NESAC shall, subject to availability extend facilities to a limited number of M.Sc./M.A. students of USTM for short duration summer/winter training courses at NESAC under the relevant guidelines. **Director, NESAC** shall be the ultimate authority to decide the topics and number of participants.
5. USTM shall provide scope to interested Scientists of NESAC, to teach certain portions of PG courses at its campus. Necessary honorarium to the resource person shall be paid by USTM as per the guidelines to the scientists of NESAC.
6. **On mutual agreement**, diploma programmes, specialized and short duration refresher courses, training and skill development programmes, and project management courses on


- topics of interest to the Government/Industry/Academia and other space based R&D activities can be jointly offered at USTM or NESAC.
7. USTM and NESAC will encourage and provide facilities to the faculty members of USTM and scientists of NESAC to explore and prepare joint research proposals on some thrust areas for funding by government and other agencies. The technical activities and grant sharing between two parties shall be defined and mutually agreed while submitting such proposals.
 8. Any intellectual property arising out of the joint intellectual input under a collaborative R&D project will be held jointly, filling and maintenance cost of which shall also shared equally. The responsibility of filing and maintaining the intellectual property shall be of NESAC. However, in the event of licensing of the IP for commercialization by USTM or NESAC to any Party, the fund accrued or likely to be accrued will be shared between USTM and NESAC at a proportion to be mutually decided from case to case basis after deducting the cost of patenting borne by NESAC on behalf of USTM. In case, USTM does not want to be a party to the intellectual property, Director, NESAC shall take an appropriate decision regarding its filling and utilization, and **vice versa**.
 9. USTM shall not file any application for seeking Intellectual Property Rights in its own name or in the name of its associates or any other person on any matter relating to the information gathered/disclosed to it by NESAC and **vice versa**.
 10. USTM and NESAC shall consult each other for any publication in respect of any project/research work. These publications shall be in the names of researchers as per intellectual contribution and as per the publication guidelines of the respective guidelines, wherein it will be duly acknowledged that the work has been carried out at USTM or NESAC under the sponsorship of the sponsor.
 11. USTM and NESAC shall extend their library facilities to the scientists, faculty members, research scholars and students in accordance with the rules and regulations that govern the functioning of their respective libraries.
 12. Apart from the aforesaid academic, management and research work, USTM and NESAC shall collaborate in the following areas as mutually agreed upon from time to time.
 - Dissemination and updating knowledge of research work being carried out through technical activities such as training programmes, seminars, symposia, workshops, publication of papers, conventions, conferences at various levels.
 - Social issues.
 - Natural Resources, Disaster Management Plans, Meteorological works, Biodiversity and Wildlife researches, Environmental and Geographical researches.
 - Recognition and rewards to individual as well as organizational achievements in scientific research, conservational activities, technology and entrepreneurship, visiting faculties.
 - Any other crucial areas of common interest.
 13. This MoU is valid for a period of five years term from the date of signing of the MoU and can be extended through proper renewal on the recommendation of the review committee. The MoU will automatically lapse after five years, unless renewed.

14. The progress of work and outcome of this MoU will be monitored annually by the review committee constituted as below:

1. **Chairman:** Vice Chancellor, USTM.
2. **Co-Chairman:** Director, NESAC.
3. Two representatives from USTM.
4. Two representatives from NESAC.



1. Within fields that are mutually acceptable and in accordance with the rules and regulations governing each institute, UGC will facilitate & coordinate the interaction of the universities of Bangladesh with USTM to pursue the following general forms of cooperation :

- 1.1 Exchange Visits by students, faculty and administrators for study and research, teaching and discussions in accordance with regulations of both governments and universities;



- 1.2 Exchange of materials in education and research, publications, and academic information, instruction and cultural programmes;
 - 1.3 Institution of fellowships in furtherance of the above objective.
 - 1.4 Exchange of information including, but not limited to, exchange of library materials and research publications;
 - 1.5 Joint research projects and programmes related to global education in the following areas and not limited to;

The objective of the University is to strive to provide employment oriented higher education and promote research in areas which are of special and direct relevance to the region in the emerging areas of Science and Technology, to meet the regional to national aspirations, and development of the state of Assam.

And

University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya, having its registered office at Techno City, 9th Mile, Baridua, Meghalaya, hereinafter called "USTM", is established by an act of Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya State in 2008. The objective of USTM is to impart world class education exploring opportunities and talents of north east region, thereby, creating cutting edge research centre and build a Knowledge Capital for societal development. USTM is an upcoming university with minimal resources and high ambition trying for academic excellence.



Whereas USTM has requested TU to mentor the upcoming university to achieve its objectives, through various programmes for the academic promotion and administrative guidance with the following identified but not limited to,

1. TU will guide USTM in **Academic promotion**, by mentoring and training the faculty, (by syllabus up-gradation, and taking special classes by TU Faculty). The universities will cooperate with each other to jointly organize academic seminars.
2. TU will guide USTM in **administration**, quality faculty recruitment.
3. TU will **guide** the USTM in managing their **research programmes** and mentor the scholars when needed. TU will also guide the faculty in preparing the DPR for projects, collaborative activities by taking lead. The Universities will, as far as practicable, exchange research information and experienced researchers with a view to mutually promote research in Science & Technology and related activities between them. The Universities will reciprocally facilitate Science based innovation and fact-findings resulting into Business development activities.
4. TU will **guide** USTM in upgrading of **university infrastructure** like laboratories, equipments, library, class rooms, recreational facilities, hostels, campus maintenance by providing necessary specifications and operational guidance where required.

Both TU and USTM agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this Memorandum of Understanding, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information- disclosing party and entered public domain.

Incidental expenses, if any with respect to the activities mentioned above will be met by USTM. Any expenditure w.r.t. visit of the TU staff to USTM will be met by USTM.

Subject to clauses below, both the **Universities** may amend this Memorandum of Understanding by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the Universities shall come into effect the date determined by the signing Universities on potential areas.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter, the **Universities** shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this Memorandum of Understanding. The Universities agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall not be legally bound. Nothing mentioned in this Memorandum of






The purpose of this MoU is to create a framework for collaboration between **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** with the objectives as given below:

- a) To establish close linkage and functional coordination between **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** along with the **ERDF** established Institutions e.g. **University of Science and Technology Meghalaya (USTM)**, **Regional Institute of Science and Technology (RIST)** and **Regional College of Higher Education**.
- b) To recognize **CSIR-CRRI** as an accredited research centre for research and study directed by **ERDF established Institutions** and vice versa.
- c) To consider the qualified scientists, scholars and professional of **CSIR-CRRI** as an accredited faculty/guide for different research, teaching programmes of **ERDF established Institutions** and vice versa.
- d) To facilitate joint seeking of funds and conduct of research, submission of project for research and development, training and consultancy with university /institutions in India and abroad.
- e) **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** shall meet the expenses for the respective purposes and activities under this MoU from their own resources.

The MoU will be governed by the following conditions:

1. **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** shall support each other towards the advancement of knowledge of the employees, faculty, scholars and students of both the organizations.
2. **ERDF** will provide all facilities to the employees (Scientific and Technical staff) and scholars (Research Fellows and Project Assistants) of **CSIR CRRI** to enroll for M.Tech and Ph.D. programme at the University of Science and Technology (USTM) established by **ERDF** under joint supervision. The course work/experiments required for the award of these degrees by USTM shall be taken up /conducted at **CSIR-CRRI** and necessary tests to qualify for registration/award of degree shall be conducted by USTM. The topics for M.Tech and Ph.D. work shall be from the ongoing research programmes at **CSIR-CRRI**.
3. **CSIR-CRRI** shall provide, without any financial obligation on its part, necessary facility to the students and faculty of University of Science and Technology (USTM) to conduct research required for partial fulfillment of requirements leading to the award of M. Tech and Ph.D. degree by USTM. Number of candidates to be taken up under each of the degrees at a time shall depend upon the availability of supervising scientists and laboratory space. Director, **CSIR-CRRI** shall be the ultimate authority to decide such number.
4. **CSIR-CRRI** shall, subject to availability and without any financial implication on its part, extend facilities to a limited number of M.Sc /B.Tech students of **ERDF** Institutions for short duration



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summer/winter training courses at **CSIR-CRRI** under the relevant CSIR guidelines. Director, **CSIR-CRRI** shall be the ultimate authority to decide the topics and number of participants.

5. ERDF Institutions shall provide scope to interested scientists of **CSIR-CRRI**, to teach certain portions of UG and PG courses at campuses of **ERDF** Institutions. Necessary TA/DA and honorarium to the Scientists shall be paid by **ERDF** as per their policy guidelines to the scientists of **CSIR-CRRI**.
6. On mutual agreement, specialized and short duration refresher course /training programmes on topics of interest to the Government/Industry/Academia can be jointly offered at **CSIR-CRRI** or Institutions established by **ERDF**.
7. **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** will encourage and provide facilities of the faculty members of **ERDF** Institutions and scientists of **CSIR-CRRI** to explore and prepare joint research proposals on some thrust areas for funding by government agencies. The technical activities and grant sharing between two parties shall be defined and mutually agreed while submitting such proposals.
8. Any intellectual property arising out of the joint intellectual input under a collaborative R&D project will be held jointly, filing and maintenance cost of which shall also shared equally. The responsibility of filing and maintaining the intellectual property shall be of CSIR. However, in the event of licensing of the IP for commercialization by **CSIR-CRRI** or **ERDF** to any Party, the money accrued and likely to be accrued will be shared between **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** at a proportion to be mutually decided from case to case basis after deducting the cost of patenting borne by CSIR on behalf of **ERDF**. In case, **ERDF** does not want to be a party to the intellectual property, Director, **CSIR-CRRI** shall take an appropriate decision regarding its filing and utilization.
9. **ERDF** shall not file any application for seeking intellectual property rights in its own name or in the name of its associates or any other person on any matter relating to the information gathered/disclosed to it by **CSIR-CRRI**.
10. **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** shall consult each other for any publication in respect of any project/course work. These publications shall be in the names of research workers, wherein it will be duly acknowledged that the work has been carried out at **CSIR-CRRI** under the sponsorship of the sponsor.
11. **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** Institutions shall extend their library facilities to the scientists, faculty members, research scholars and students in accordance with the rules and regulations that govern the functioning of their respective libraries.
12. Apart from the aforesaid academic and research work, **CSIR-CRRI** and **ERDF** shall collaborate in the following areas as mutually agreed upon from time to time.
 - Dissemination and updating knowledge of research work being carried out in North East through technical activities such as seminars, symposia, workshops, publication of papers, conventions, conferences at various levels.




