## बेहतर शिक्षक हों तो प्लेसमेंट समस्या नहीं : हक

युक्त शिक्षा और उच्च शिक्षा के वैश्वीकरण के इस दौर के बन गए हैं। असम व पूर्वोत्तर के क्षेत्रों में, जहां प्रतिभा पलायन दशकों के लिए नग्न का केंद्र है, मौजूदा शिक्षाविद और शैक्षणिक-विदेश में महत्वपूर्ण योगदान देना चाहते हैं कि इससे प्रतिभा-युक्तों के साथ विकास का नया को मिलेगा। ऐसे ही एक शिक्षा-विद हक से सत्यनारायण रायण से सवाल किए। उत्तरों सहित नीचे:

को क्या लगता है, असम में शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में मांग और आपूर्ति में सुधार हुआ है? : देशक, डिमांड तो बढ़ी है, पर आपूर्ति भी यहां इकट्ठे नहीं है। देश के १-७ इंजीनियरिंग कालेजों में अतिरिक्त विद्यार्थी नसीब नहीं हैं, अतः वे विद्यार्थियों में बाहर का

चस्का लगा हुआ है। वे चले जाते हैं। आपूर्ति की स्थिति सुधारने के लिए औद्योगिक प्रोथ बहुत जरूरी है, जो अभी यहां नहीं के बराबर है। मांग तो है, लेकिन उसे फुलफिल करने युवाओं को बाहर जाना पड़ रहा है। सरकार को निजी संस्थानों से सीटों का तालमेल कर बेहतर माहौल देना चाहिए।

■ उच्च शिक्षा में निजी पूंजी निवेश की राह में क्या बाधा है?

हक : इसे ऐसे समझें-रायल है, ईआरडीएफ है, हमारे जैसे गिनती के उच्च शिक्षण संस्थान हैं। हमलोगों की कुल ३६० सीटें हैं, वे यदि फिलअप नहीं हुईं तो स्वाभाविक है कि वित्तीय बाधा तो दिखेगी। खासतौर से हमारे सामने है। वातावरण हतोत्साहपूर्ण है तो इसमें सरकार को भी ध्यान देना होगा। यहां इसकी नितांत कमी है। निजी निवेश में इसीलिए बाधा आती है।

■ क्या असम में ही अच्छी गुणवत्ता वाले संस्थान होने पर भी युवा बाहर जाना चाहेंगे?

हक : कुछ बात तो पहले कह दी है। दरअसल हमें फाउंडेशन मजबूत करनी होगी। जिलों में जाना होगा। बेशक, छोटी-छोटी जगहों पर बेहतर स्कूल खोलने से पैसा नहीं मिलेगा। लेकिन उनसे निकले विद्यार्थियों में यहीं रुककर शीर्ष उच्च शिक्षण संस्थानों में ठहरने का जज्बा बढेगा। गुणवत्तायुक्त शिक्षा

■ काबिल शिक्षकों (फैकल्टी) की उपलब्धता की क्या स्थिति है?

हक : अब कुछ ठीक हुई है। निजी संस्थानों में भी काफी आकर्षक वेतन-भत्तों के कारण। लेकिन पहले से शिक्षकों की कमी की खास वजह छोटी जगहों पर विज्ञान व वाणिज्य शिक्षा पर जोर नहीं देना है। जो माध्यमिक स्तर पर विज्ञान की शिक्षा अधिकतर विद्यार्थी नहीं पाएंगे तो इससे शिक्षक कहां से आएंगे! स्कूलों में इससे प्रति काउंसिलिंग, गाइडिंग बहुत जरूरी है।

■ संस्थान की लोकप्रियता या रैंकिंग में पढ़ाई का स्तर ही कारक है या इस प्लेसमेंट की भी बात आती है?

हक : आईआईटी में विद्यार्थी प्लेसमेंट की वजह से नहीं जाते। वे वहां जाते अथवा जाना चाहते हैं तो इस वजह से कि सब बेहतर शिक्षक वहां है। हमारे पास बेहतर शिक्षक है तो बच्चों को प्लेसमेंट तो मिलेगी ही।

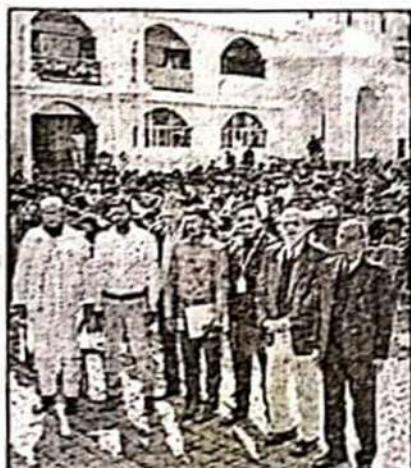


# Mega recruitment drive at USTM

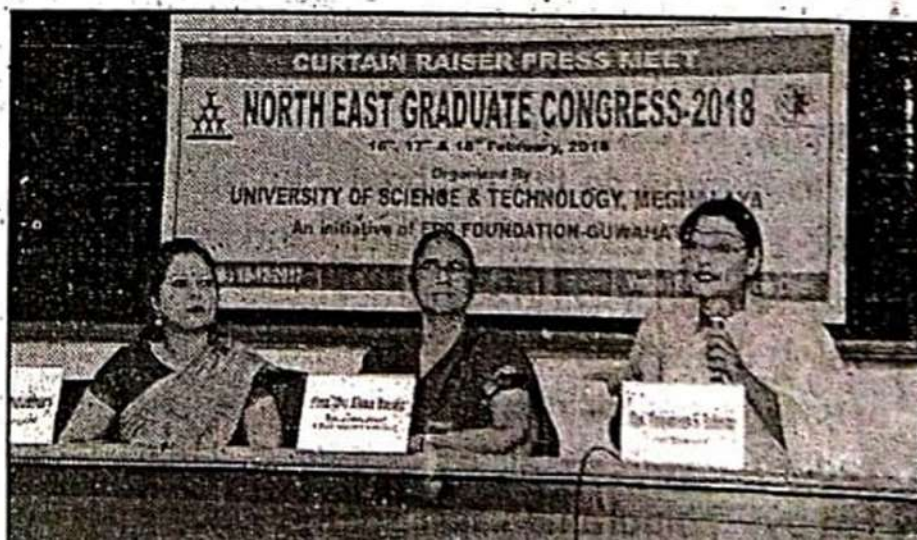
