INSTRUCTIONS FOR DAPE & FAPE

- The Pre-Department Day presentations by departments will be held after 6months from the commencement of classes of the session; Annual Department Day presentations will be held after one year from the commencement of classes of the session.
- 2. The departmental presentation will be scheduled within 45days from the end of classes of the semester.
- 3. The DAFE & FAPE is evaluated on the parameters mentioned for both the department and individual faculty.
- 4. Faculties have to publish atleast 2 papers in journals of national/international repute having good impact factor in a session.
- 5. To provide sufficient time to faculty and to create a research environment, the management has take decision that from the new semester onwards every alternate Saturday shall be a holiday for the students and faculties shall come for research and paper publication. The working hour for these Saturdays shall be till 4pm. However, if and when need arise considering the completion of syllabus, the facility may be withdrawn.
- 6. The score for Publications & Research will be given by Prof Amarjyoti Choudhury, CV Raman Chair Professor of Applied Sciences. The faculties are to update their Publication & Research information with the Senior Research Officer.
- 7. The score for the standard of questions set will be given by Prof Amarjyoti Choudhury, CV Raman Chair Professor of Applied Sciences.
- 8. Proof for Media Coverage like paper cuttings, photographs etc are to be filed so that it can be shown during the presentation.
- 9. A Photo Album of various Welfare Activities is also to be maintained.
- 10. Contribution in Events must be recorded along with recommendations from Committee.
- 11. The score for the Cultural Contribution will be given by Cultural Forum, Sports Participation from Sports Forum, Competitive Exams by Directorate of Competitive Examinations.
- 12. Regularly irregular faculty in both entry to campus & Classroom & also exit from the campus & classroom will not be included as performer faculty. Even though their name emerges as performer. A sum of Rs 1000/- will be deducted from the faculties who are regularly unpunctual.
- 13. Feedback of students will be categorized based on their seriousness & performance to minimize the error.

Areas To Be Covered In Future Evaluation:

- ➤ Performance Evaluation for administrative staff /operational staff and also students will be covered phase wise under CAPE and will be presented time to time.
- > School-Wise Performance will also be covered in the next evaluation.
- ➤ Parameters like **Punctuality, Higher Education/Achievement, students** care & monitoring shall be added to the next FAPE.
- > Standard of Questions set by both the Department & individual Faculty will also be evaluated.
- ➤ DAPE will also include parameters like **Talents Database** related extracurricular & participation in indoor/outdoor activities, sports, culture along with **presence**, **participation** and **professionalism** of **students/Faculty**.
- ➤ Display/Exhibition of achievements Department-wise in the next Annual Performance Day.

Merits & Demerits

MERITS:

- ➤ Post evaluation Indicators helps management/sponsor to understand and appreciate the performers along with advisory idea for others.
- ➤ Eligible and qualified Faculties got the opportunity to work at USTM and so this evaluation is not degrading one's status/dignity but to know the performance status with respect to performance shown by fellow faculty and also to know the desire/satisfaction level of students on the faculty's accomplishment/delivery.
- ➤ The system is a yardstick for career advancement like promotion, increment and incentives etc.
- ➤ It will help identify the non-performers and category-wise also instigate them to improve their performance.
- It will help management to take up schemes for faculty development.
- ➤ The evaluation aims for the progress of the faculty guiding and assisting them in achieving efficiency and competence.
- ➤ The evaluation offers an opportunity to think about the upcoming year and develop goals and set targets.

DEMERITS:

- ➤ The system at the initial stage may have some marginal errors; possibility of 10-20% errors in collection data & subsequent evaluation in both DAPE and FAPE.
- ➤ The evaluation may lead to low self esteem to low performers.
- ➤ In some case few students out of gurge give less mark to the teacher, in the same way some students in some cases give undue high score to some teachers from whom they get undue favor.
- ➤ Attendance of some faculty members is high but delivery of his/her service is less.






Graphical Representation of Students Growth


UG Admission Status for the last 3 years




PG Admission Status for the last 3 years

- 1. Invite Guest Lecturers from Jamia Millia Islamia, Gauhati University, IIT Guwahati and Tezpur University
- 2. To conduct Workshops on Creative Literature.
- 3. Literary fest covering North East writers and their themes
- 4. Publication of at least 6 Research Papers in Journals by Faculty members and students

Dept of Library & Information Science:

- Initiate the process for building an IR (institutional repository) on the model of UGC-Infonet.
- 2. Conduct a workshop on Library Marketing or Library Software.

Dept of Law:

- 1. Workshop on "Constitution of India" in collaboration with Gauhati University.
- 2. Hold Moot Court Competition involving Law colleges affiliated to Gauhati University.
- 3. Organise North East Law Graduate Conclave-2017

Dept of Education:

- 1. National Seminar on "Eco-friendly environment & survival" with Aaranyak.
- 2. National Workshop on "Life Skill Education" with Gauhati University.

Dept of Physics:

1. Planning & application for UGC-SAP programme.

Dept of Public Admin & Political Sc:

- Workshop on "Changing issues/concepts of Political Science" in collaboration with Indo-Pacific Studies, JNU, New Delhi.
- 2. Organise Youth Parliament.

LEAVE RULE

ERDF expects faculties and employees of USTM to report to work on all scheduled working days and during all scheduled work hours and to report to work on time. To keep all the Departments running smoothly and efficiently without loss of a single class during the period of academic season it is important that every faculty and other employees shall plan their personal work coinciding with the declared paid holidays.

However ERDF recognizes that even after proper planning the personal work schedule, the faculties and employees may still have to remain away from work in inadvertent, unavoidable and unforeseen situations like illness, bereavement, medical care of family members etc.

Keeping this in view the paid leave policy is designed as follows to protect the academic interest of students and financial interest of the faculties and employees.

- The paid leave up to 12 days (twelve) days in a calendar year will be admissible to the faculty members.
 The paid leave of up to 12 days in a calendar year will be available on the ground of illness, bereavement or any personal work of extreme urgency.
- 2. Only one day paid leave will be admissible per month during the period of semester classes.
- 3. The day/days of absence in a month caused by any external factor other than natural calamities will be adjusted with admissible paid leave but with prior communication.
- 4. On a given day the paid leave will be allowed by competent authority taking into consideration the number of other faculties of the Department present so as to manage the classes without affecting the teaching and learning environment in the campus. It is very important to sustain the learning environment in the USTM campus at high level. As such paid leave will be considered only when it is feasible to manage all the classes with adjustments.
- The faculty members are encouraged to avail the admissible paid leave during the period of study leave and breaks given to student after examination utilizing the saved and unutilized paid leaves during the same calendar year.
- 6. Faculties/employees will be required to proceed on paid leave only after having the paid leave granted by the competent authority on submission of application in the prescribed leave application form.
- 7. The Registrar or an officer authorized by the Vice Chancellor will be competent to grant paid leave of one day in a month during the period of Semester classes. Unpaid leave during Semester Classes has to be granted in exceptional circumstances.
- Any absence without prior leave sanction will be treated as unauthorized absence and will be viewed
 with disfavor and for each day of unauthorized absence pay cut will be made at the rate of double the
 gross salary of one day as deterrent.
- 9. No carry forward of paid leave from one calendar year to another will be admissible. However an employee who has unutilized paid leave in his credit at the end of a calendar year will be entitled to encashment of unutilized paid leave provided that number of unpaid leave(including unauthorized leave) during the semester period is minimal.
- 10. For three days late attendance in a month one day's salary cut will be affected and for absence in four classes in a month one day's salary cut will be made.
- 11. Avoiding paid leave is always encouraged and in such cases incentives will be offered by the end of every semester based on their dedication and performance.
- 12. In the event of death of a parent of an employee paid leave of up to five days in addition to normal paid leave will be granted to perform the last rites.
- 13. Paid leave of three days may be allowed to an employee for his/her marriage.
- 14. The above paid leave policy will be applicable to regular staff and officers of administration as well with the condition that it will not have any relationship with the academic season. The leave to be granted to officers and staff will be based on the condition that the normal functioning of administration is not adversely affected.


