Action taken based on Students' Feedback :

1	Field visits to enhance practical knowledge of the syllabus.	Time to time the department organizes various field visits in different policy institutions in Guwahati and village councils of Meghalaya as well as in other places
2	Reference books for preparation of UGC NET in the department will be helpful.	A good number of reference books for the preparation of UGC NET in the departmental library were made available in the department.

Action taken based on Faculty Members' Feedback :

Sl. No.	Feedback	Action Taken
1	Uniformization of the existing syllabus of all the courses so that timely coverage of syllabus can be achieved.	The department resolved to revise the syllabus with 4:3 structures (4 units and 3 sub-units) for all the courses. Earlier it was 4:4 or 4:5 or even 4:6 which was difficult to cover within time.
2	Introduction of courses on exclusion, diplomacy, and administration in India.	The department introduced new courses on Social Exclusion: Theory and Practice (MPS 305 C), Diplomacy: Theory and Practice (MPS 405 C), Public Administration in India (MPS 306 B).
3	Inclusion of more relevant textbooks and journals for education and research.	Several relevant textbooks and e-resources have been acquired in the central library.
