
- Most of the students (88%) agreed to the statement that the syllabus is relevance to the programme, need-based and updated.
- Around 84% of the students agreed to the statement that the syllabus covers recent trends and developments
- There is an agreement (74.6%) to the fact that the syllabus has a good balance between theory and application.
- Around 81% of them agreed that quality of reference materials as mentioned in the reading list of the syllabus is relevant to syllabus.
- The syllabus is relevant to professional development and preparation for jobs for 76% of them.


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
EXTENT OF THE INCLUSION OF THE LATEST DEVELOPMENT IN THE SYLLABUS

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
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BALANCE BETWEEN PRACTICAL AND THEORY




QUALITY OF REFERENCE MATERIALS AS MENTIONED IN THE READING LIST OF THE SYLLABUS

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


THE CURRENT SYLLABUS IS ADEQUATELY FOCUSSING ON EMPLOYABILITY OF STUDENTS

ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM (July 2021-June 2022)


The Alumni feedback form consisted of questions that truly indicated their satisfaction level about the syllabus. Given below are the conclusions obtained by analyzing the student's feedback for the academic year 2021-2022.

- All alumni (100%) strongly agreed to the statement that the syllabus is relevance to the programme, need-based and updated.
- Around 69.231 % of the alumni strongly agreed and 30.769 % agreed to the statement that the syllabus covers recent trends and developments
- There is an agreement (92%) to the fact that the syllabus has a good balance between theory and application.
- Around 46.154% strongly agreed and 53.846% agreed that quality of reference materials as mentioned in the reading list of the syllabus is relevant to syllabus.

- Around 100 % alumni satisfied with the overall structure of the syllabus.




TEACHER FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM (July 2021-June 2022)


- About (85.8%) strongly agreed to the statement that the syllabus is relevance to the programme, need-based and updated.

- About 85.8 5 agreed that the prescribed books listed as reference materials are relevant, updated and appropriate.


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- 100 % faculties satisfy with the contact hours stated in the syllabus for completion and coverage of the syllabus.

- Besides these faculties needs more laboratory equipment's for practical purposes.




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
