Intake Capacity and Reservation policy for Admission

01. Intake Capacity: The maximum number of student to be admitted to the various degree programmes in each year shall be decided by the Academic Council as per recommendation of BOG/Sponsor. The Controller of Admission and Examination will notify the intake capacity in every year before admission based on the approval of Academic Council.

02. Reservation of seats: The Academic Council of the University shall determine reservation of seats in various degree programme. The reservations of seats are subject to revision in time to time based on the recommendation of BOG/sponsor/Govt. Bodies. As a private university there is no direction from State Govt. regarding cast wise reservation. However considering the location of the university in the state of Meghalaya, the following reservation policy in various academic programme have been approved by the Academic Council of the University.

A) Reservation for Meghalaya domicile: 30% seat in each programme is reserved for Meghalaya students as per direction of the state Govt. of Meghalaya. This reservation is not over and above the reservation mentioned in clause **2.02.02:B and 2.02.02:C.**

B) SC/ST/OBC and Others:

Scheduled Cast (SC) : 5%

Scheduled Tribe (ST): 30%,

Other Backward Class (OBC): 12.5%

Persons with Disability -2%,

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) – 2%

J & K domicile students = 2 seats per programme.

Unreserved: 48%

C) Reservation for Girls Students: 33% girl students in all branches under different Schools of study to encourage girl students for Higher Education, as decided by the sponsor ERDF. This reservation is not over and above the reservation mentioned in clause **2.02.02:B.**

Vacant seats under reserved category will be made open for all after last date of application on non-availability of eligible applicants.



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The merit list for the general category seats will comprise of all the candidates in the order of merit. The candidates from reserved category shall apply for both general and reserved quota. A candidate shall be excluded from the SC/ST/OBC merit list just because he belongs to general category list. Such candidates are entitled to be considered general category first followed by reserved category. Admission to open category seats will be in the order of overall merit without considering SC/ST/OBC/others category.

3. Provision for admission of USTM/ERDF Employees: Employees of USTM/ERDF will be given special opportunity for higher education on the basis of NOC approval from competent authority of ERD Foundation.

4. Provision for admission for Foreign / NRI candidates: Foreign / NRI candidates shall be consider for admission in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the UGC and Govt. of India and fulfilling the minimum admission requirements of the university.

5. Age Limit: There is no minimum and maximum age bar for admission to the Diploma, under-graduate, post-graduate, Ph.D. programmes in the University except in the programmes where the respective regulatory bodies (such as AICTE, NCTE, PCI, BCI etc.) have prescribed the minimum and maximum age requirement in their regulations.
