Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Council for Social and Digital Development (CSDD) & Department of Rural Development, University of Science & Technology (USTM), Meghalaya

This Memorandum of Understanding records the understanding arrived among the Council for Social and Digital Development (CSDD), Plot 159, Farm Gate, Khanapara, Guwahati – 781022, Assam and between Department of Rural Development, USTM, Ribhoi, Meghalaya.

 THE PURPOSE of this Memorandum of Understanding is to recognize the roles and responsibilities of both the parties.

In particular the Memorandum of Understanding is intended to:

- 1. Establish the roles and the responsibilities of both the parties.
- 2. Develop the timeline of the project
- 3. Recognize the people involved.
- 4. Enhance the functionality of the parties.

#### II. BACKGROUND OF THE PARTIES INVOLVED

The Council for Social and Digital Development (CSDD) (<a href="http://csddindia.in">http://csddindia.in</a>) is a section 8 Not For Profit Company under the Companies Act of 2013, working with specific focus on social and digital inclusion and mainstreaming in North East India in domains of research, advocacy and actions.

The Department of Rural Development (USTM) (<a href="https://www.ustm.ac.in/rural-development-academic-focus/">https://www.ustm.ac.in/rural-development-academic-focus/</a>) was started in 2012 with 6 students for M A in Rural Development and the present strength is 75 including Masters and PhD. Being multidisciplinary in nature, the department undertakes both teaching and research in the areas concerning rural development, agriculture, indigenous technology, extension education and gender issues.

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#### III. PROPOSED ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH SCOPE OF WORK UNDER THE MOU

The proposed scope of work between the two parties is as follows:

- The broad thematic area of the proposed academic and research work is 'Mapping the Changing Social Dynamics of Rural and Community Development in North East: Investigating Theoretical and Applied Aspects'
- 2. This research work shall cover key study aspects as areas of investigation covering rural development students, learners, practitioners, researchers and others –
- Sociological mapping and investigation of existing and emerging factors in community and rural development.
- ii. Social factors and aspects in rural and community development including in North Eastern Region.
- iii. Role of social agencies and institutions in community and rural development.
- v. Social innovations and good practices in development including traditional knowledge and practices.
- v. Role of technology in rural and community development and social aspects of technology in development.
- vi. Knowledge exchanges and networks on experiences and examples
- vii. Role of NGOs/CSOs/CBOs/ SHGs and others in rural and community development.
- viii. Policy aspects in social, community and rural development.
  - Knowledge levels in students / youths / locals of these in North East. These broad areas will be investigated through identified social and sociological aspects and variables, either in support or as barriers to community and rural development.

#### IV. ACTIVITIES UNDER THE PROJECT

- 1. Enhance and build newer perspectives, learning levels in social aspects of community and rural development in studnents, learners, practitioners (theoritical and practical).
- 2. Add professional aspects and capacities in students, learners, practitioners in social problem solving, management of community and rural development towards social problem solving of rural development challenges and towards employability.
- Enhance and build further knowledge resources, content in social aspects of community and rural development for theoritical and applied perspectives.
- 4. Organise knoweldge netowork programmes in workshops involving students, learners, practitioners and experts in social dynamics of community and rural development in North East India.
- Development of knowledge products in research papers and publications in areas of changing dynamics of community and rural development including innovations.

#### Roles and Responsibilities

## Role of Council for Social and Digital Development

1. Lead the project and its execution with the Department of Rural Development (USTM). Jointly review the project with DRD, USTM.

2. Provide project two core team members to execute the deliverables with close coordination with the Co-Supervisor of the project and team at USTM. The project Academic and Research Associate (equivalent to Assistant Professor Level) to be engaged at DRD, USTM and another Research Associate at CSDD level). The team to support the Department (USTM) and the team in strengthening the Department academic and research activities as part of the project deliverables in alignment with project objectives and activities.

3. Provide budget support to the project (as specified below).

 Jointly plan, execute, review and achieve the project deliverables. Co-supervise the project with project supervisor at CSDD.
