Held in the North East India for the first time, this two-day-long mega academic event is jointly organized by the Indian Political Science Association (IPSA) and USTM on 26th and 27th of March.

The inaugural session of the Conference began with welcome address by Prof. Gauri Dutta Sharma, VC, USTM. Then Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma, VC, Mahatma Gandhi Central University and General

The International Women's Day-2022 has been celebrated on 8th March by different departments of USTM at Jorbil village, USTM campus as well as at the Sijubari area of Guwahati city.

The Social Work Department of USTM celebrated International Women's Day by organizing awareness talk on women empowerment, wage discrimination at work place and other legal systems at Sijubari LP School in Guwahati. The Chief Guest on the occasion was Ms Joyshree Khersa, SP, F & E Guwahati city. This year's theme is "Gender Equality Today for a Sustainable Tomorrow". The event took place in a slum area amongst the women of minority community to sensitize them on legal rights with special reference to domestic violence. In order to conduct the programe smoothly, the department distributed leaflets 2 weeks before the program amongst the community people. The student social workers mobilized the community people a week before the program. In her speech, the chief guest said that women can receive assistance and support from police department whenever required with proper proceedings.
