




Figure 1: Online workshop on Hybrid Multi Cloud Architecture & Industry 4.0




Figure 3: Resource person taking online session




Figure 4: Mr Sriram Kumar D.K taking online session




Figure 3: Prof. Jyotiprakash Goswami, Professor of Computer Application Department, Assam Engineering College






