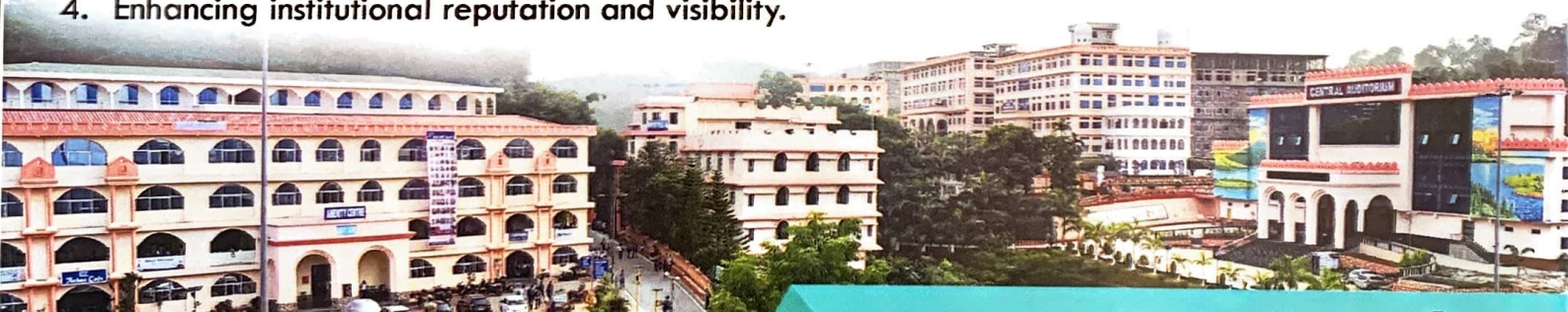

Delivering effective classroom lectures is a skill that requires careful planning, clear structure, engaging presentation, and interactive strategies. A good lecturer should prepare the lecture content and visual aids in advance, and familiarize themselves with the classroom layout and equipment. A good lecturer should also show the students how the lecture relates to the course goals and previous and future topics, and use transitions and summaries to highlight the main points. A good lecturer should use voice, gesture, eye contact, and visual aids to capture and maintain the students' attention, and avoid reading from a script or slides. A good lecturer should also involve the students in the learning process by asking questions, posing scenarios, using clickers or polls, or assigning small-group activities.

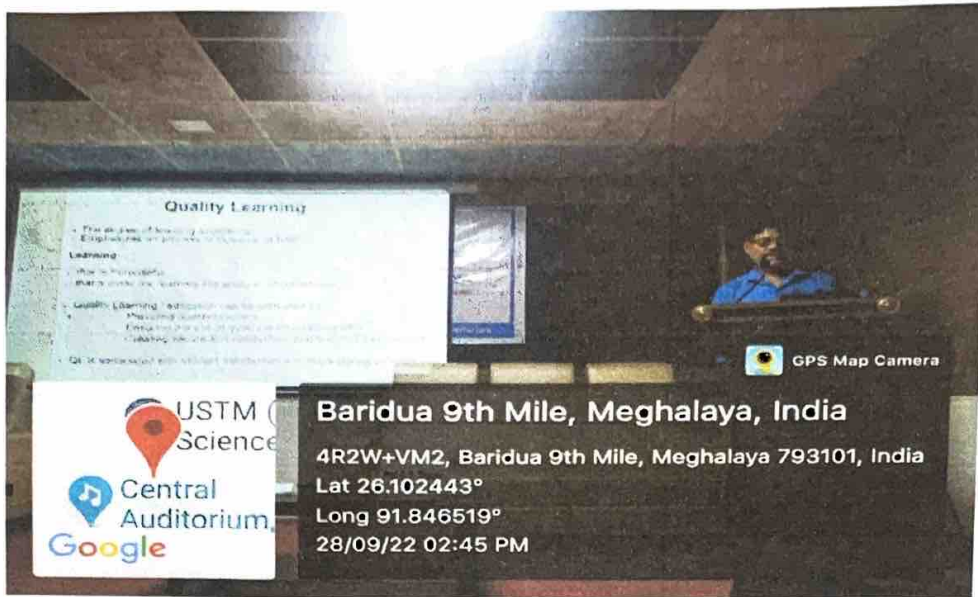

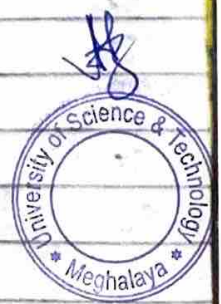

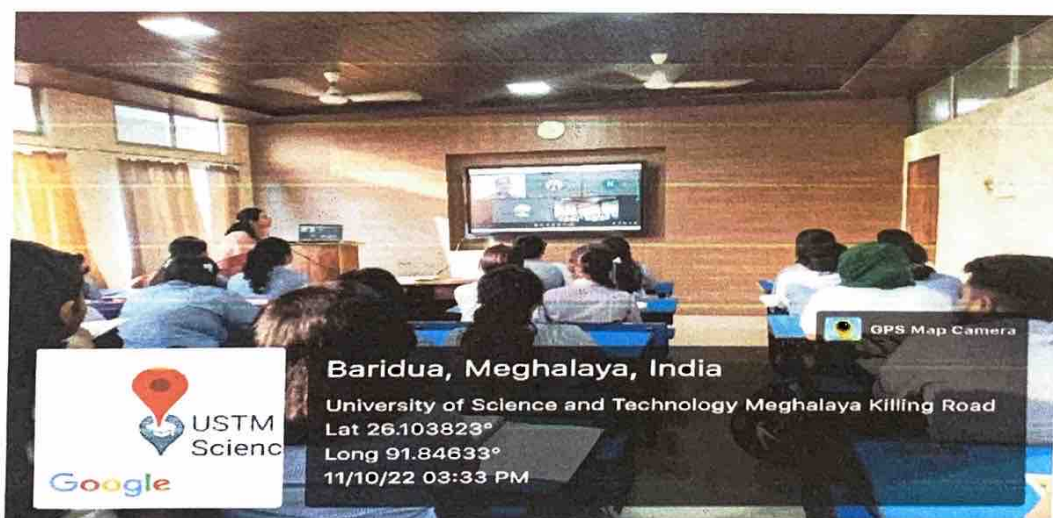
9. ACTIVITY REPORT WITH DETAILS:

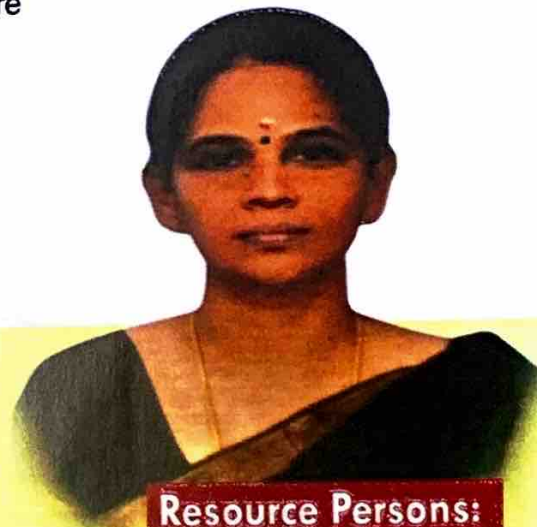
